Application Deadline – June 1, 2008

The applicant should be an incoming freshman in the fall of 2008. The applicant must have a strong agricultural background involving 4-H and/or FFA Swine Projects and a strong emphasis in swine while at college. Preference will be given to applicant who has a strong desire to remain active in the swine production industry after graduation.

### **One \$3,000 Alliant Energy – Interstate Power & Light Scholarship**

The applicant should be an incoming freshman in the fall of 2008, have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership abilities while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to an applicant from the Southeast District of Iowa
